

MEMORANDUM FOR GROUP (CC) AND AEO

SUBJECT: Aerospace Education Display Contest

1. As usual, there will be an Aerospace Education Display Contest held at the Wing Conference. The Conference, this year, will be at Lake George, NY on the first weekend in May.
2. The theme for this year is taken from Module 5 of *Aerospace Dimensions*, but not limited to the material contained in that textbook. The theme is: "Planets of Our Solar System."
3. The goal is create a display that can be set up at a shopping mall, public library, county fair, airshow, fly-in breakfast, or any other place where CAP might be invited. It should be attractive enough to encourage a passer-by to pause and have a better look at it. It should be clearly labeled so that a person can understand the point being made without someone being there to explain it. The labels, however, should be fairly concise. If desired, a list of books and/or films recommended for further study may be offered as a handout. It is also a good idea to have a handout listing the names, locations, and meeting nights of ALL the Squadrons in the Group when the display is used in a public place.
4. Each Group is entitled to submit one display for the contest. It may be created by one Squadron to represent the Group or by members from two or more units working together. The display should be designed to fit on one 6 ft. or 8 ft. table. Background can be something like science-fair project boards on the table, itself, or set up on easels behind the table. The background will not be taped or tacked to the wall!
5. This year's theme will be carried through in the Aerospace Education Seminar where Capt Richard Lauricella will be giving a presentation on the planet, Mars.
