



## Emergency Services INCIDENT COMMANDER'S KIT

These items are required to be in the Incident Commander's Kit. The initial kit is supplied by the Wing Director of Emergency Services. This will be satisfied by a compact disk with all of the material that can be placed on that disk. Other items, especially road maps and aeronautical charts will be sent to the ICs. Once the initial kit is delivered to the ICs, it is then their responsibility to restock their kit.
