



NEW YORK WING OPERATING INSTRUCTION 11-12

Personnel

SUBORDINATE UNIT COMMANDER TERM LIMITS

This instruction prescribes the procedures for limiting the terms of commanders for Groups, Squadrons and Flights within the New York Wing.

1. Group, squadron and flight commanders shall serve a probationary period of one year followed by an additional 2 years for squadron and flight commanders and 3 years for group commanders.
2. For squadron and flight commanders, the group commander may grant an additional one-year term for a maximum term of 4 years.
3. For extraordinary circumstances, the Wing Commander may grant further extensions. These extensions will be for a 1 year period and must be fully documented and justified.
4. In no circumstance may a subordinate unit commander's term exceed 6 years without the approval of the region commander.
5. Once a commander has been relieved, they cannot reassume that position in the same unit for a minimum period of 2 years.

Transition Period

6. All group, squadron and flight commanders who have served more than 4 years and those that will have completed their 4-year term by 31 December 2011 will be relieved. This transition period will commence 1 August 2011, and all affected commanders must be replaced no later than 1 March 2012.
